INTRODUCTION

Pollution Prevention Resource Center (PPRC) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization incorporated in the state of Washington in 1990. PPRC is the Northwest Region's largest nonprofit organization that provides on-the-ground technical assistance to local, state, and federal government, communities, non-profits, businesses, and other partners who are seeking to reduce pollution at its source and improve their economic vitality. PPRC has worked with the Clackamas River Water Provider (CRWP) since 2014 to deliver technical assistance and outreach to automotive businesses and landscapers using the EcoBiz Certification standards. PPRC has been working with CRWP since 2016 to implement Clackamas River drinking water protection projects.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

During the 2022/23 fiscal year, PPRC contracted with CRWP to continue implementation of drinking water protection projects. The following table outlines the Proposed Tasks and Completed Activities during 2022/23.

Proposed Tasks	Description of work completed
Perform outreach at businesses that could receive hazardous material education and technical assistance.	PPRC contacted and offered technical assistance to eight (8) commercial and industrial facilities within the Clackamas River Watershed. Provide spill prevention and response training to up to eight (8) commercial and industrial facilities.	PPRC provided spill prevention materials to seven (7) commercial and industrial facilities.

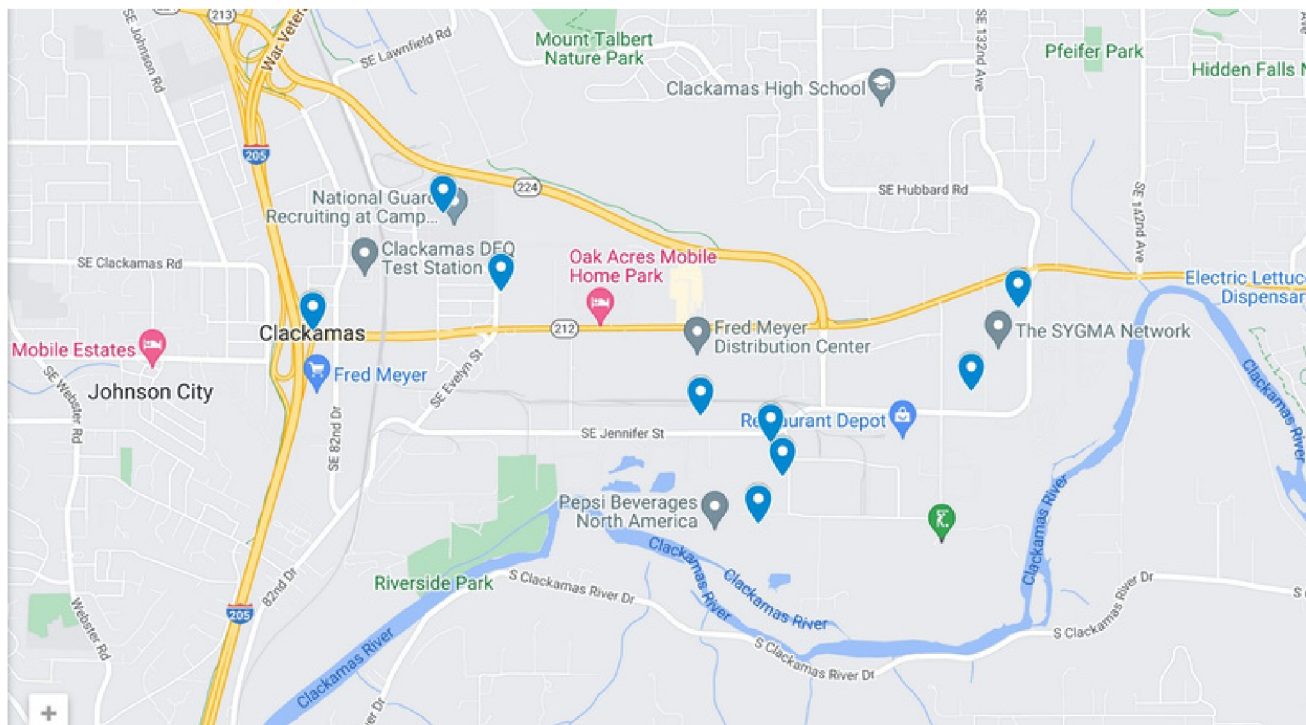
